- USDA RD BTA: Hammil & Furnace Creek June 20
- FCC ACP Outreach: Regional ACP Enrollment Events June 30
- CPUC Last-Mile Federal Funding Account (FFA)
  - Application Window: Opens June 30-ish, open for 90 days (+ 2<sup>nd</sup> Round)
  - Application Tool: Available as of June 8
  - Allocations: \$10,600,000 for Mono, \$13,220,000 for Inyo
  - Application Scoring: 20/120 Points for Local Agency or Tribal Partnership
- CASF Infrastructure Account Next window closes April 1, 2024
- CA BEAD-Funded Grants: 2024 or 2025, Separate Grant Program.










## CA BEAD & Digital Equity Plan
